The Mt. Hamilton District was one of the richest silver districts in Nevada. The remains of mines and prospects are everywhere around Mt. Hamilton and gold and silver companies continue to file claims on large tracts of ground. The district is off of Hwy 50 roughly half way between Eureka and Ely.

The Bedlam claim is an old silver mine with two portals. One portal is a 45 degree shaft and the other is a horizontal shaft. The claim was mined in the 1800's during the Mt. Hamilton Silver Rush. The Mt. Hamilton silver rush lasted roughly from 1865 to 1875 and when the silver ran out the area was abandoned.

A good road leads to the mine making it easy to transport prospecting equipment. Lead and silver can be found in the tailings and assays from the mine shaft show $\frac{1}{4}$ oz of gold per ton.

There is a developed BLM campground 10 miles away, and numerous other campsites on the road to the claim capable of supporting one or more RV trailers. This is primarily an old silver mine, but assays of ore also show gold of up to $\frac{1}{5}$ oz. There are numerous gold claims in the area.
