This mine is located in the historic Greenhorn District in Baker County, Oregon. The Greenhorn District is a well known gold district. The Greenhorn District is on the line between Baker and Grant County. The Fries Mine is within Baker County, but the northern edge would be the Grant County Line.

Mining within the Greenhorn District began as early 1895 but by 1910 most mining was already in decline, but some degree of mining continued up until the 1950s but production was largely sporadic and low. The opportunity for the small scale miner in this district is to process ores which were considered too low grade by the early miners, and metal detecting old ore dumps.

The Fries Mine is a historic mine with the ruins of a significant mine and a fairly substantial headframe. From the Lidar image you can see there are significant workings within the boundaries of the claim. The claim location is provided below.

Access to the claim is by 4WD and there is camping nearby for trailers or RVs. It's recommended you scout the road to find a suitable camp site.
